## **Parent Forum**

I would like to thank everyone that attended parent forum, we will endeavour to provide you with as much notice as possible moving forward. I have included below some information around some of the discussions held and some answers to further questions. I would also like to thank Jane for talking notes, leading discussions and for sending us such a lovely email which I have shared with staff  $\bigcirc$ 

#### How can we improve school systems to help school communicate with parents?

Ormston school will be the first within the Polaris group to launch the new MIS system in September, this will make it easier for us to do things like send group mailings/emails and updates – we are very excited about this. James discussed how parents should be receiving a minimum of weekly contact with their class team and how he has met with staff so they can share more information about what they have been learning. James has also asked for staff to share information about trips and visits with more notice so that parents/carers are aware and can talk about this at home. Parents/Carers know how much we do in school but really want to know all about it – let's share the great things that we do

#### How do we receive newsletters and information?

We send newsletters (usually every week) home with young people however should they "go missing" you can find them on our website and in reception. I have also purchased an outdoor notice board for the carpark to display any key information for those parents/carers who collect and drop off young people.





## How often do we have parent forums?

We will be holding parent forums every half term, each forum will have a different focus. E.G. Safeguarding, Curriculum and Life Skills. This is so you are provided with a deeper insight into your child's time at school. Some of these meetings may also be held with class teams so you can look at and discuss the progress your child is making in school. We will share dates of parent forums with as much notice as possible.

#### Will staff have further autism awareness training?

All staff in school have access to the learning portal as well as taking part in mandatory and optional training. Further 'in person' Autism training is planned for staff during INSET at the end of this academic year. Every Tuesday staff take part in training opportunities tailored towards the needs of the school and young people.

#### Can you get some more outdoor equipment?

Our Forest School is well underway and is already taking shape. More recently we have purchased monkey bars, and the caretaker has even made a mini obstacle course. To further develop this area, we have ordered Exercise Bars and more break/lunch time equipment. As we develop further, we will investigate additional equipment and hopefully have the opportunity for an indoor gym space within the Moorfield House building.

#### Have you thought about a PTA?

I am open for a further discussion with parents around ways we can work together. I will ask Miss Carruthers to reach out to parents in the new year 😊
