Snowy Owl

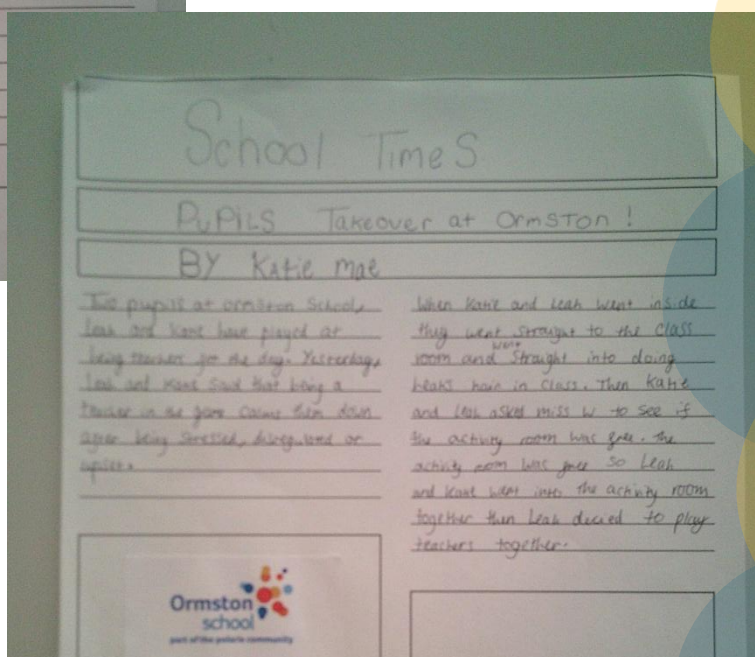
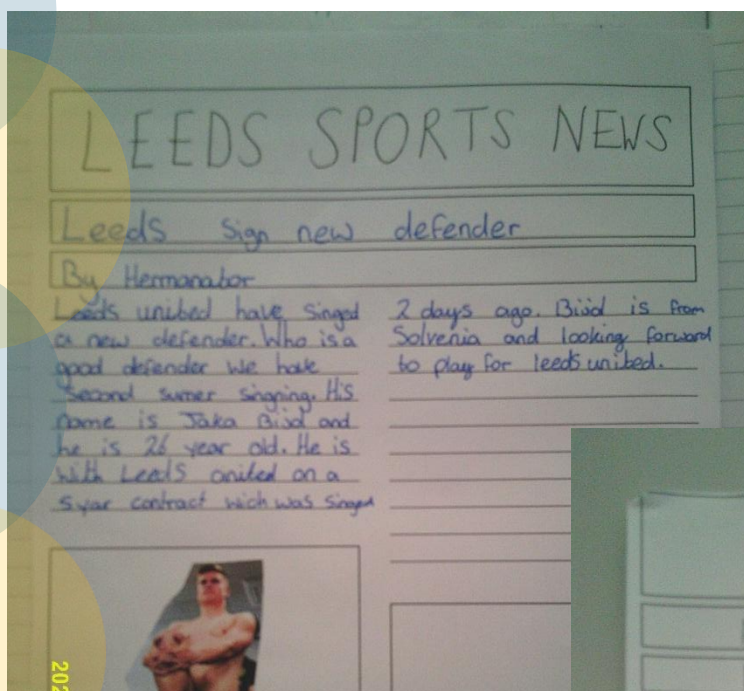
